COMMUNICATION

At Texas P-10 State School, we value effective communication between schools, parents, the community and students as the foundation in developing and maintaining partnerships.

- Staff connect with the parent/s of every child in the school (regular phone calls, communication books, informal discussions).
- Communication to community (school newsletter, local paper, website, QSchools App, School Noticeboard, Class Dojo App, Facebook). Could you say something about P&C meetings
- Calendar of events advertised in school newsletter outlining upcoming events.
- Parent Information evenings.
- Term Snapshots/Curriculum Overviews distributed.
- Class Dojo to inform parents of daily events and learning activities.
- Prep Transition occurs in term 4 of each year (Information morning, 2 x transition mornings, visits by Prep teacher to early childhood centres).

COMMUNITY COLLABORATION

At Texas P-10 State School, we believe that schools do not exist in isolation – they are often the central hub of their community. We look for a variety of ways for the Texas community to work together for the benefit of all.

- Generate and maintain contact with relevant health professionals in the area (school nurse, GO, Headspace, Immunisations, etc).
- Open school facilities for community use (Little A's, Junior and Senior Netball, First Lego League Team).
- Excursions to the Historical Museum, Rabbit Works, Town Library, Foodworks and Art Gallery.
- Texas Show Students perform (dance and sing), student work on display, school equipment is shared with the Show Society for the event.
- Local businesses support Year 9 students with placements for Work Experience.
- Under 8's Day is celebrated and responsibilities shared between school, day care and kindy.
- P-3 students visit Mingoola Aged Care to perform Christmas Concert for residents.
- P&C cater for Year 10 End of Year Dinner.
- Year 10 Students participate in Community Collaboration at Community Health.
- Principal contributes to Community Advisory Network (CAN) meeting each month.
- P&C provide catering on-site for various charitable organisations that travel through town.

PARTNERSHIPS WITH PARENTS

Learning is not limited to the classroom at Texas P-10 State School. The belief, expectation and experience of parents is a powerful determinant in student's achievement. Understanding the school, home and community contribution to student learning helps cultivate a holistic learning environment.

- Home readers sent home in the primary school.
- Report cards and parent-teacher interviews inform parents of where their child is sitting in their learning journey.
- Prep Orientation Day.
- Collaborative celebration days with the local childcare centre and Kindergarten group.
- ParentTV Online parent professional development to support families with the child's development.
- Parent helpers within the classroom and at school sporting events
- A Homework Policy, has been endorsed by P&C. Parents support students with the completion of homework.

DECISION-MAKING

Texas P-10 State School provides opportunities for relevant consultation to ensure decisions reflect local needs – whether for an individual student or the school as a whole. Greater community ownership and trust of school directions and decisions are developed through open and authentic consultation.

- School opinion survey.
- P&C meetings.
- Parent surveys.
- Parents welcomed and regular invited to give feedback to Principal and staff.
- Stakeholder meetings for vulnerable students.
- Parent body is involved in 4-yearly review and strategic planning.

SCHOOL CULTURE

Parent and community participation in student learning and the school community is highly valued at Texas P-10 State School. This involvement sends a clear signal to students about the value of education.

- New students (and families) are given a tour of the school and introduced to members of staff and their future peers. Enrolment interview with the Principal held before student commences.
- Parents attend parades, school events and school ceremonies.
- Families attend '100 Days of Prep celebration'.
- Major ceremonies and events are advertised so that parents can attend.
- School ANZAC Day Ceremony is open to the community to attend for those that are unable to attend the Dawn Service.
- A whole-school Awards Ceremony is held with staff, students, parents/guardians and community members.
- School socials.
- Adopt-a-cop involved with safety messages and support of students and staff.
- Student work celebrated in the 'Window of Opportunity' in the town main street.
- Texas Has Talent Concert is a community concert that showcases Instrumental Music students work along with other school and community members.
