Texas P-10 State School will receive

\$110,060*

This funding will be used to:

- achieve 100% of non-identified students demonstrating agreed reading benchmarks
- establish consistent approaches to support students at risk of not achieving reading benchmarks
- maintain growth for 100% of students achieving at/or near end of year benchmarks in Term 1
- ensure 100% of teaching staff are using data walls to inform practice
- increase parental satisfaction of learning progress to 90%.

Our initiatives include:

- the creation and enactment of a 'Parent/Guardian Engagement Framework' to support increasing parental satisfaction (learning progress) results from 78% to 90%
- the formation of single year level classes (Prep – Year 6) to allow increased focus on specific curriculum and individual instruction/teacher support
- reviewing and adjustment to the 'Data & Evidence Plan'
- refinement and articulation of processes which support vulnerable students (non-verified, verified, Indigenous, high achieving)
- using the work of Sharratt, Archer and Hattie (via Visible Learning website) to inform practice and policy development.
